Jesus as Saviour

Jesus' death and resurrection proves to Christians that he is the Saviour that God promised and the path to salvation. Through Christ's death on the cross, Christians are saved from eternal damnation and are given the hope of salvation. Through his death and resurrection, Jesus atoned for the sins of humanity, allowing them to be **reconciled** with God.

Christianity teaches that Christ is the only way to salvation, and that salvation will be for those who believe, as well as those who do not believe.

The people of El Salvador are largely Roman Catholic Christians. It is a relatively poor country whose people have suffered many conflicts in recent times. Christian bishops, priests and nuns have even lost their lives standing up for the poorest people in El Salvador, but the people have faith that the future will be more just and peaceful.
