<b>baptism</b>	a ceremony that symbolises a commitment to living a life as a Christian
<b>symbolism</b>	is when one object or thing stands in the place of something else
<b>blessings</b>	in religious rituals, it is said the God blesses those who are good, or people can bless God
<b>nativity</b>	the <i>Nativity</i> is the birth of Jesus, which is celebrated by Christians at Christmas
<b>census</b>	a count of the people who live in a country
<b>Bethlehem</b>	an ancient town in the Middle East. It is important to Christians, who believe it is where Jesus Christ was born.
