<b>Vocabulary</b>	
<b>Bible</b>	the main sacred writings of Judaism and Christianity – made up of the old and new testament
<b>God</b>	a being that is worshipped and believed to have special powers over nature or life
<b>Creation</b>	the act of creating or of causing something to exist
<b>Christians</b>	concerning, or coming from the person, actions, or words of Jesus Christ, or the religion based on his teachings
<b>Genesis</b>	the beginning or origin of something – the first book of the Old Testament
<b>World/Earth</b>	the universe; everything that exists
<b>Harvest</b>	the gathering of ripe crops, the crops or the amount of crops gathered, or the season in which they are gathered.
<b>Thanks</b>	an expression of gratitude
<b>Care</b>	the act of watching over or tending; protection
<b>Nature</b>	the physical world and living things in their natural state; all things that are not made by people
<b>Provider</b>	to give what is needed; supply
