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General Knowledge

When designing a product for sale we must consider the buyer, the purpose and its use. A design brief tells us what the product needs. You must meet the design brief for the product to be suitable,

When using material to create a product we must make sure we carefully cut out our templates on the material. We need to ensure we use the correct needle and thread type to join our material. It is important to remember health and safety when sewing as needles are sharp. Practicing different types of stitching before sewing your final product is helpful to make sure it is neat.

Once a product has been created it is helpful to think about what worked well and what might be done differently next time, this is called evaluating.
