Romans leave Britannia (Britain)

By AD 410, the last of the Romans had left Britain making them vulnerable to invasion. The warriors that invaded became known as the first Anglo-Saxons. Most of Britain was divided into seven Anglo-**Saxon kingdoms**. The **Picts** and **Scots** were a constant threat without Roman support.

What was life in Anglo-Saxon Britain like?

Anglo-Saxons preferred to live in small villages. Anglo-Saxon influence can be seen in place names in Britain today. **Wessex** was a place named after the **West Saxons** who settled there. Sussex was named after the South Saxons.
