How do some stories from religions and beliefs and the example set by some people show me what to do?

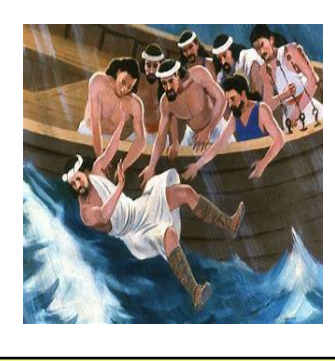
What values are important to me, and how can I show them in how I live? (Fairness, honesty, forgiveness, kindness)



Vocabulary	
reflect	to think about; to ponder
honesty	honesty means more than "not lying." Honesty means your actions are truthful too.
forgiveness	a deliberate decision to release feelings of resentment
fairness	concept that something should be equal but also treating someone according to their needs
kindness	is a genuine, deep and selfless concern without expecting anything in return
Moses	Moses is the most important Jewish prophet
Ten Commandments	the Ten Commandments were written by God upon two tablets of stone and then given to Moses on Mount Sinai.
Jonah	a prophet who disobeyed God and was punished by being swallowed by a great fish, or whale, until he agreed to carry out God's order



The story of Moses is one of the most important bible stories as it teaches us about courage and bravery and about helping others.



Jonah was a man who was given a special job by God but he ran away from it by getting on a boat that took him the other way from where God wanted him to go.
