Maths




This term, our Key Instant Recall Fact (KIRF). This term it is **to say numbers in order to 10**. This includes counting both forwards and backwards from any number to 10. Throughout the term they will cover, shapes with 4 sides, continue to subitise from 0-5, find 1 more and 1 less than a given number and start thinking of how numbers are made (composition).

Top tips

- **Tricky words:** Keep practicing their tricky words at home and remember, these can only be read by sight.
- Practice your child's **Math's learning step** that is in their reading record.

ALL OTHER LEARNING

In **Music** this term, children will be learning to listen to and appraise a variety of songs. They will learn familiar songs and sing plenty of nursery rhymes each day. They will also be learning the songs for the Nativity.

In **PE** they will be practicing their *Dance skills*. They will need to come up with dance move ideas, remember these and use co-ordination to perform.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED) will be where the children learn about "Celebrating Difference." They will be thinking about themselves, families and what makes us all special.

Our **RE** topic this term is called: 'What is Christmas?' The children will explore the Christmas Nativity story and discuss the key characters within this story.
