

Incarnation

Incarnation is the Christian belief that Jesus Christ is the God of Israel in a human body. The word incarnate comes from Latin and means "in the flesh"

Trinity

In the Christian religion, the Trinity is an idea used to explain that three different persons are called God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit (who is sometimes called the Holy Ghost). Trinity states that these three all form the same God.

Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is the third part of the trinity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit that is the way Christians understand God

Baptism

For babies: In the church, the vicar explains that when the baby is baptised, he becomes part of God's family and can listen to stories about Jesus in the Bible. The vicar also explains that baptism is a new beginning and the sign of the cross shows that the baby is special to God.

For adults: Often adults choose to be baptised later in life as people believe you can "repent and be baptized, adults believe their sins can be forgiven and they will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
